Aizawl, the 5th of August, 2020

NOTIFICATION

Consequent upon the Ministry of Home Affairs' Order No.40-3/2020-DM-I(A) dated 29.06.2020, the Government of Mizoram had relaxed certain restrictions. This along with the resumption of domestic flights on 25.05.2020 has facilitated movement of the public which has lead to an increasing number of people travelling to and from the State. Meanwhile, the process of return of stranded residents of Mizoram from other States is almost completed. Therefore, the Government is of the view that it is no longer necessary on its part to continue to bear all the expenses for the quarantine and testing of persons travelling to the State on personal and work related matters. Hence, all expenses related to quarantine and testing of persons returning to/entering the State shall be borne by the persons concerned with immediate effect and until further orders. The following procedure shall henceforth be adhered to in the process of quarantine.

Category A

Permanent residents of Mizoram stranded in other States who have lost their jobs due to the pandemic and returning to Mizoram on or before 31.07.2020; residents of Mizoram who had traveled to other parts of the country before the imposition of lockdown and facing financial distress as duly verified by their respective Deputy Commissioners '*returning to the State on or before 31.07.2020*'* and persons referred to other States for medical treatment shall not come under the purview of this Order.

Category B

This category shall include all Mizo and non-Mizo residents of the State. These persons shall spend at least 14 (fourteen) days in Government quarantine facilities and the expenses including rent, fooding and COVID-19 tests shall be borne by them or their sponsors (in case of non-domiciles who require ILP) as per the table shown below.

The cost of board and lodging for 14 (fourteen) days shall be paid to the Deputy Commissioner in advance at the time of admission into the quarantine facility.

Category C

This category includes non residents of Mizoram who have to visit the State briefly on official business and technical experts or persons with specializations whose services are required by Government Departments, Companies or individuals. Such persons will be allowed to stay only in hotels or guest houses empanelled by the Government (Deputy Commissioners) for the purpose. The cost of board and lodging, transportation and COVID-19 tests shall be borne either by the individual or their sponsors.

A person in this category shall be administered the COVID-19 test as soon as they arrive and he/she shall be allowed to proceed to work only when such a test is negative. During their stay they shall be permitted to visit only the sites/offices that are part of their work itinerary. They shall not be permitted to visit other places or mingle with other persons. The arrangement for the transportation from the quarantine facility to their place of work and back shall be made by the sponsoring Department/sponsors in consultation with the Deputy Commissioner concerned and no separate arrangements shall be made by the individual concerned.

Category D

This category includes workers who may be required by Public Sector Undertakings, construction companies and contractors for undertaking large infrastructure development projects. Persons under this category shall be quarantined for a period of 14 days at their work site if arrangements for quarantine at such sites under intimation to the Deputy Commissioner concerned. The sponsors shall also be sensitized about all the existing Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) on quarantine, the period of quarantine to be observed and maintenance of hygiene and disinfection by the Deputy Commissioner concerned and Health & Family Welfare Department who shall undertake inspections to ensure their compliance. All the expenditure for setting up the quarantine facility including the fooding and COVID-19 tests shall be borne by the company or contractor concerned. If no suitable buildings or locations can be arranged at the work site, quarantine shall be done as given under category B.

Category E

This category includes any person who prefers to spend 14 days quarantine in more comfortable accommodation at their own expense. They shall be permitted to be quarantined at hotels or guests houses empanelled by the Deputy Commissioner in advance, the rent and fooding cost shall be fixed by the Deputy Commissioner in consultation with the owners of such facilities. Such hotels/guest houses shall not be permitted to have other guests and they shall follow scrupulously all the Government guidelines on maintenance of hygiene and care of quarantined guests as well as instructions to be followed by staff/management.

Transportation from Lengpui airport

Any person arriving at Lengpui airport, whether they are destined for Aizawl or other districts shall utilize only those taxis/rented cars empanelled by the Government for the purpose of transporting quarantine bound passengers. Own vehicles of passengers may also be used as long as proper partitioning is made between the driver's and passengers' seats. The fare for empanelled taxis/rented cars as per the rates fixed by Deputy Commissioner, Aizawl shall be borne by the passenger. Passengers bound for other districts who are required to transit in Aizawl shall head directly for the Transit Quarantine Facility without halting enroute.

Other important instructions to be followed

Any person staying at the aforementioned quarantine facilities shall immediately inform persons on duty or the medical helpline 102/0389-2323336/0389-2318338 if they develop COVID-19 symptoms.

The health status of all quarantined persons shall be examined before leaving the quarantine facility and no person shall be permitted to leave without a negative COVID-19 test result.


